The Principals of 65 new Government Degree Colleges established during the academic years 2008-09 & 2009-10 are requested to out source the non-teaching sanctioned posts as per in annexure – I, while following the out sourcing guidelines as mentioned here under.

### **Guidelines:-**

- 1. the Principal employer for out sourcing Agencies shall have to register his office or department as per the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Adoption) Act. 1970.
- 2. the out sourcing agency at the time of obtaining contract labour licensee for supplying man power to the Principal employer shall pay necessary fees and deposits into Government Treasury.
- 3. the outsourcing Agency shall renew its license every year.
- 4. the outsourcing agency is responsible for payment of remuneration to each individual before the expiry of such period as prescribed.
- 5. the Out sourcing Agency should pay the remuneration as ordered by the Government from time to time to the categories of posts indicated therein.
- 6. the individuals sent by the outsourcing agency are eligible for 15 days Casual Leave per year or Proportionately to the actual out sourcing period.

The Principals Newly Started 65 Government Degree Colleges in the State are requested to send necessary proposals for providing the Budget to the Outsourcing services.
